

REPORT OF WORLD OZONE DAY CELEBRATION.

College environment and climate Cell and College Eco club DHSK College organized a talk on "Ozone and its Importance" on the eve of "World Ozone Day" i.e. 16th September, 2023 in collaboration with Department of Botany.

In the beginning of the program, Dr. Alakananda Baruah welcomed all the students and told that it is a day to remind students about the significance of the Ozone layer, the efforts at global scale that have helped in its road to recovery and the need to continuously search possible solutions to preserve it by eliminating man-made chemicals.

Mr. Abhilash Bhattacharjee, the resource person for the event, while providing information about the ozone layer through his ppt lecture, said that the day commemorates the signing of the Montreal Protocol in 1987, the most successful ecological agreement till date. He explained the causes of ozone layer depletion with a particular focus on human activities such as the use of Chlorofluorocarbons (CFCs) and other ozone-depleting substances. In his lecture, Mr. Bhattacharjee discussed the broader environmental impact of ozone layer depletion, including increased UV radiation, which can lead to skin cancer, cataracts, and harm to the ecosystems.

The lecture concluded with a discussion of future challenges, such as monitoring and ensuring continued compliance with Montreal Protocol, as well as adapting to the changing climate.

The event served as a reminder that collective action and environmental stewardship are essential for safeguarding not only the ozone layer but also the health and well-being of present and future generations.
